



Corners

Create four large signs (A, B, C, D or Noun, Pronoun, Verb, Adverb or Add, Subtract, Multiply, Divide or WWI, WWII, Vietnam, Civil or any other 4 answers) and hang one of the sign in each corner of your classroom. Prepare at least 30 questions with the 4 possible answers. Cut all the questions apart, students individually draw a question and move to the correct corner. The first time the teacher checks for accuracy, simply tell them "right" or "wrong" and give them the opportunity to move to a different corner. Teacher preference if you allow your students to talk during the activity or be silent.

Once all the students are in a corner, have them read their questions out loud. Depending on the number of original questions or preference of repeating questions this process can be completed for multiple rounds.
