

UP 4 IT

1. Make a series of questions on a PowerPoint and have an answer key ready for game time. (It is helpful to denote whether it is the red team's or blue team's questions.)
 2. Divide the students groups of 4.
 - a) Each group of 4 will then divide into 2 teams: the blue team & the red team.
 - b) Instruct each group to draw a 7 x 7 grid on their large whiteboard or large paper posted on the wall – this is their game board!
 - c) Each of the two teams within the group needs a mini-whiteboard, marker & eraser.
 3. Project question #1. Give all teams a set amount of time to work. If it is the red team questions, go around and check the red team's boards. If they have the answer correct, have them put a red circle on the game board. If their answer is incorrect, check the opposing blue team's boards. If they have the answer correct, they have stolen the questions and get to put a blue circle on the game board.
 4. Continue through the questions. Once a team gets 4 in a row, they mark it up as a win. They then erase their game board and start a 2nd game.
- *You could give bonus point certificates or other prizes for each win.
*You could also play this with actual Connect Four game frames instead of drawing each game board on a large whiteboard or poster paper.
